





## Oswaldkirk Village Walk on Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> March 2020

This 4.9-mile walk takes in some unique views of our lovely local countryside and significant historical sites starting at Coxwold > Wildon Grange > Angram Grange > Angram Hall > Shandy Hall.

This is a dog friendly walk but they need to be on a lead on farmland with livestock (some sheep, horses and cattle). There are 2 stiles, gently undulating, approx 3 hrs with a snack'n'drink break. The walk starts at 11.15 am from The Fauconberg Arms in Coxwold (Parking on the hard-standing to the left and right of the FA) – see the walker image for location.
